AGREEMENT

I certify that the information in the entire registration packet (including all documentation, the Registration Form and Health Form) is true and accurate. I realize that supplying false information will result in the loss of my child's space at Camp Lifeline and forfeiture of any registration fees.

I approve of my child's participation in Camp Lifeline. I consent to the use of any audio or visual records of the child named on this Parental Agreement form, without remuneration, to be used, distributed or displayed as agents of Camp Lifeline see fit. I understand that Camp Lifeline reserves the right to deny my child's participation in Camp Lifeline due to illness, as deemed by Camp Lifeline's medical staff prior to departure for camp. I acknowledge that I have received and agree to Camp Lifeline's policies as delineated in the *Important Information*.

I understand that if my child exhibits extreme disruptive behavior and it is deemed by the camp leadership that the camper needs to return home, it is my responsibility to pick up my child from Camp Lifeline in Falling Waters, West Virginia. I understand that if my child exhibits disruptive behavior on the return trip home from camp, my child will be fined in 50 cent increments for each time one of the camp's rules is broken, and that I must provide the total amount upon arrival.

I have read and agree with Camp Lifeline's dress code policy. I understand that Camp Lifeline is a place where children and youth focus on their relationship with Jesus. As such, the dress code policy is based on the principle of modesty, as certain styles of clothing can be a distraction for many. I understand that anyone in violation of this policy will be asked to change clothes or make the appropriate changes to render their clothing modest. The dress code is as follows: Shorts and skirts must be long enough to reach below the fingertips when standing. Pants or shorts should not sag. If so, belts must be worn. Clothing of all kinds should not be sheer or tight. This includes leggings, jeggings, and super skinny jeans/pants. Undergarments must not be visible. Tank tops, muscle shirts, or sleeveless shirts, if worn, should be worn underneath another shirt. Modest swimsuits must be worn. Females should wear one-piece swimsuits or may opt to wear a swim shirt over the swimsuit. Males should wear swimming trunks, not bikini or Speedo-type swimwear. Attire with references to alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, gang affiliations, or indecent or sexually suggestive subjects is unallowable.

I understand that my child's camp counselor may be in touch with them to see how they are doing after their return from camp. I agree that Camp Lifeline and its representatives may maintain contact with my child after camp.

Unless due to the willful fault or negligence of Camp Lifeline, ImageMakers Ministries, its officers, directors, employees, and/or volunteers, I discharge and release Camp Lifeline, ImageMakers Ministries, its officers, directors, employees, and/or volunteers from any and all claims, demands and liabilities for property damage, personal injury and/or death to my child or my property. I will not sue, or commence any legal action, complaint, or charge against Camp Lifeline, ImageMakers Ministries, its officers, directors, employees, and/or volunteers regarding any matter covered by this agreement and release.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have carefully read this agreement and release of liability, that I am legally responsible for the child identified as a camper on this form, that I am qualified to sign this agreement, and that I agree with its terms as binding to myself, my heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns.
